Good afternoon and thank you for joining us. As members of the Friends, you contribute significantly to our work including today participating in the governance of our federally incorporated registered charity.

This AMM deals, of course, with our work in the fiscal year ending in 31 March of this current year. You were all furnished electronically with my annual report for the year and it has also reached a broader audience via our newsletter. It continues to attract much favourable attention as it matures in scope and depth.

And to be sure our material contribution to the CWM continues unabated and in late July at an event at the museum, we presented a cheque in the amount of \$104,000 reflecting our contributions over 2 years.; I do hope you have seen the photo in the August newsletter; the smiles tell the story.

Dear Friends, donors and supporters, thank you for continuing to stay the course. Collectively we all share in the significant efforts and achievements all of which are products of your commitment. Before I close, I would like to quote the appreciative remarks by Caroline, our DG which appear in the frontispiece of our website:
