Ms. Marta Mulkins is a federal Public Servant in the Department of National Defence, serving since late 2018 as an Executive in several portfolios including in Data, Innovation and Analytics and more recently in enabling strategic oversight, management and coordination of specific complex, multi-organizational litigation activities.

She is also a long-serving member of the Naval Reserve, starting as a Diesel Mechanic in 1985 and becoming a Maritime Surface (now Naval Warfare) Officer where she served in both sea-going and shore-based positions of increasing responsibility, including commanding HMCS KINGSTON and SUMMERSIDE in 2003-2005, and a deployment to Afghanistan in 2006, until her eventual appointment as Commander of the Naval Reserve in 2015. A graduate of the United States Naval War College's year-long Naval Command College (Class of 2012), she continues to serve in the RCN on a part time basis.

A professional landscape architect, she also has experience in both private and public infrastructure sectors, joining the Federal Public Service in 2001 in the Real Property Branch of (now) Public Services, Procurement Canada where she worked in the Real Property and Parliamentary Precinct branches

Ms. Mulkins holds a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture from the University of Toronto, a Master's Degree in Defence Studies from the Royal Military College, and a Master's Degree in International Relations from Salve Regina University.
